CHALLENGE

Security, Compliance and Cost Control

A healthcare clinic faced challenges around sending and receiving traditional faxes. Outgoing faxes were sent anonymously over analog phone lines, providing no auditability for compliance purposes. Incoming faxes were often left on the printer tray, providing very little security of the information. This left the clinic vulnerable to possible HIPPA violations and fees.

SOLUTION


Outgoing Fax

The clinic's administrators now swipe a proximity card for authentication, increasing security protocols and enabling an audit trail. The users specify recipient fax number and can add notes and/or comments to the outgoing fax, creating more contextual faxing. Scanshare sends the fax to the intended recipient at %recipient @faxdomain.com and eFax solution sends fax to recipient. Smart OCR scans medical document for Social Security Number, allowing strict HIPPA compliance with Audit Trail.

Incoming Fax

Incoming faxes are received via a monitored email (incomingfax@company.com) and imported directly into a workflow. Faxes are then stored into Scanshare Repository, as based on the incoming fax number. Security is increased as faxes are no longer printed and vulnerable while waiting for collection.
